Journalism

Project Criteria

- Write a hard news story of your choice in journalistic style.
- Prepare a typed article: minimum of 400 and a maximum of 800 words.
- Include a headline to your article.
- Please include existing documentation, articles or facts that your article is based on.

Judging Criteria

- Quality of writing: Is it factual and not opinion? Does the writer use clear, concise, language? Is the story written with active verbs and descriptive phrases?
- Quality of reporting: Is the story complete? Did the writer use credible sources representing different sides of the issue? Are the readers' questions answered?
- ❖ Balance: Are all sides of the issue reported fairly? Is the information presented in an objective manner?
- Completeness: Is the entire story presented or will readers have to go elsewhere for important information?
- Did the writer thoroughly investigate the issue and report the information?

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
